Russell C. Tabor, 63, Barron, Wis., died Saturday, Jan. 22, 2011, at Luther Midelfort Northland hospital, Barron.

He was born July 10, 1947, at Rice Lake, the son of Clark and Marjorie (Miller) Tabor. He grew up in Barron and graduated from Barron High School in 1965. He served in the U.S. Army.

After his discharge from military service, Russell returned to Barron and attended UW-Barron County, Rice Lake, for 2 years and UW-Stout, Menomonie, for 2 years, graduating in

He began working for the Barron County Day Development Center in August of 1977 as administrator, where he worked until the time of his death.

Surviving are his mother Marjorie (stepfather Virgil) Anderson of Barron; sisters Linda Blyton of Bernalillo, N.M., and Marcia Tabor of Benton, Ark.; as well as nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles and many special friends.

He was preceded in death by his father and a sister Roni Olson.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 26, from First Lutheran Church, with Rev. Bruce Beyer officiating.

Burial will be in the spring at Greenwood Cemetery, Town of Dallas, Barron County, with military rites accorded by Barron VFW Post #8338 and American Legion Post #212.
